

Keynote Speaker Fr. Paul Schenck

Fr. Paul Chaim Benedicta Schenck is a Catholics United for Life speaker, has an office on Capitol Hill, and directs the Respect Life Office for the Diocese of Harrisburg. He holds degrees in biblical studies, theology, the humanities, and health care ethics. Fr. Schenck was raised Jewish. As an adult he converted to Christianity and became an Anglican pastor. Later, he and his family united with the Catholic Church in 2004. He was ordained a Catholic priest in 2010. When he was a Protestant minister, he challenged a federal court order prohibiting pro-life sidewalk counseling and literature distribution. The case, Rev. Schenck v. Pro-Choice Network, reached the United States Supreme Court which ruled 8-1 in his favor, striking down the order as a violation of the First Amendment right of freedom of speech.
