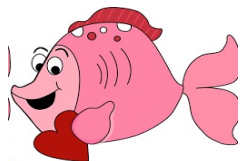

- ❖ The law of Fast permits only one full meal a day. It binds those who have celebrated their 18th birthday and continues until they have celebrated their 59th birthday.

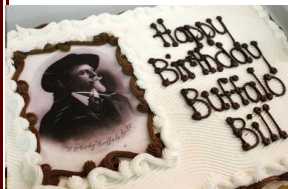
