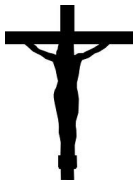

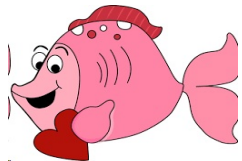
**LENT BEGINS on Ash Wednesday - February 14<sup>th</sup>**

- ❖ Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent are days of Fast and Abstinence.
- ❖ The law of abstinence forbids the consumption of meat. It obliges all those who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- ❖ The law of Fast permits only one full meal a day. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. It binds those who have celebrated their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday and continues until they have celebrated their 59<sup>th</sup> birthday.
