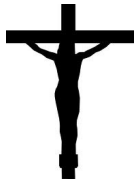

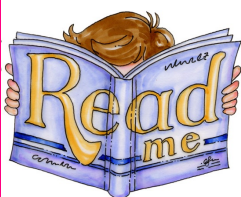
STATIONS OF THE CROSS
