OFFICE OF READINGS AND MORNING PRAYER:

From Holy Thursday to Holy Saturday, there are no 8:30am or 12:15pm masses. Instead of the normal daily masses, we will publicly celebrate the Office of Readings and Morning Prayer. In order to help you pray through these most holy days of the year, please plan to attend these beautiful liturgies at 8:30am in the morning on March 29th, 30th, and 31st, led by Fr. Brian. Materials will be provided, and each liturgy is expected to last about half an hour.



GOOD FRIDAY, March 30th is a day of fast and abstinence. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast, i.e. having only one full meal and two lesser meals that day. In addition, all Catholics 14 years old and older must abstain from eating meat.

Please Note! The Office will close at noon on Holy Thursday, March 29th and reopen at 9am on Monday, April 02. If you have an emergency please call the rectory at 587-3388.

Two of the special ministries that are reserved for the Laity are the Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion and the ministry of Lector. If you are being called to one or both of these ministries, please plan to attend a training session on Thursday April 5, 2018 at 6:30pm in the sanctuary of the church.

Training for these two ministries is mandatory. Requirements are 1) you must be at least 18 years of age 2) you must be in good standing with the Church.

This training should last 60 minutes. Current ministers who are wanting to be refreshed or expand the ministries they are doing are encouraged to attend. I pray that you will answer this call to serve God's people.
