Understanding the Word: The Infancy Narrative in Matthew roots Jesus firmly within the story & heritage of Israel (Mt. 1:1-17), establishing him as the "Son of David" (Mt. 1:1) & the fulfillment of scripture (Mt. 1:22-23). The Matthean Jesus will be portrayed as the new Moses who comes not to abolish but to fulfill the law (Mt.5:17). And yet Matthew hints that Jesus' birth is also good news for the Gentiles. The story of the magi introduces pious Gentiles who recognize Jesus as "king of the Jews," despite his humble birth. With their gifts of gold & frankincense, they become the fulfillment of Isaiah's vision (Isa. 60:6). (Living the Word)
