**2020 Oberammergau Passion Play Pilgrimage**  
Bishop Steven invites you to join him and Father Tom Cronkleton on a Pilgrimage to the 2020 Oberammergau Passion Play from September 26-October 5, 2020. In addition to the Passion Play, we will visit the Dachau Concentration Camp Memorial, King Ludwig's Castle, Liechtenstein, Lucerne, the Cathedral in Cologne with the relics of the Magi and a Rhine river cruise ending with a wine tasting. **"BEING CATHOLIC"  
and RCIA PREPARATION**

Join us for a Lively Class and Discussion on our Faith. We will observe our faith from different angles and different horizons and observe how everything is interconnected. **Understanding the Word:** Seldom do all four Gospels include the same story with very similar wording. However, the acknowledgment of John that "one mightier than I is coming" is echoed from Mark 1:7 ( the source for Luke & Matthew) to John (1:26-27). Even the late-first-century Jewish historian Josephus knows of John the Baptist (Antiquities 18.5.2). In today's reading, Luke does not narrate Jesus' actual baptism, but we do glimpse the heavenly affirmation: "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased" (Luke 3:22). Luke may have wanted to avoid the awkward theological problem: If John proclaimed a "baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins" (Luke 3:3), why would Jesus need such a baptism? Similarly, the evangelist John does not narrate the actual baptism.

**Reflecting on the Word:** Baptism clothes us with Christ. We are to bring the Christian dignity of that garment unstained into everlasting life. Titus directs us in how to do that. We are to live "temperately, justly, & devoutly in the age" That is, we are to live with self-control, growing in biblical justice, that is, right relationship with God & one another. We are to be people of prayer & devotion or holiness, to which every baptized person is called, no matter our state in life or lifestyle. **(Living the Word)**
