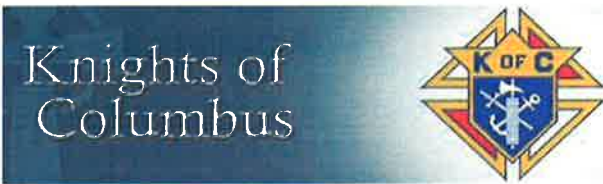

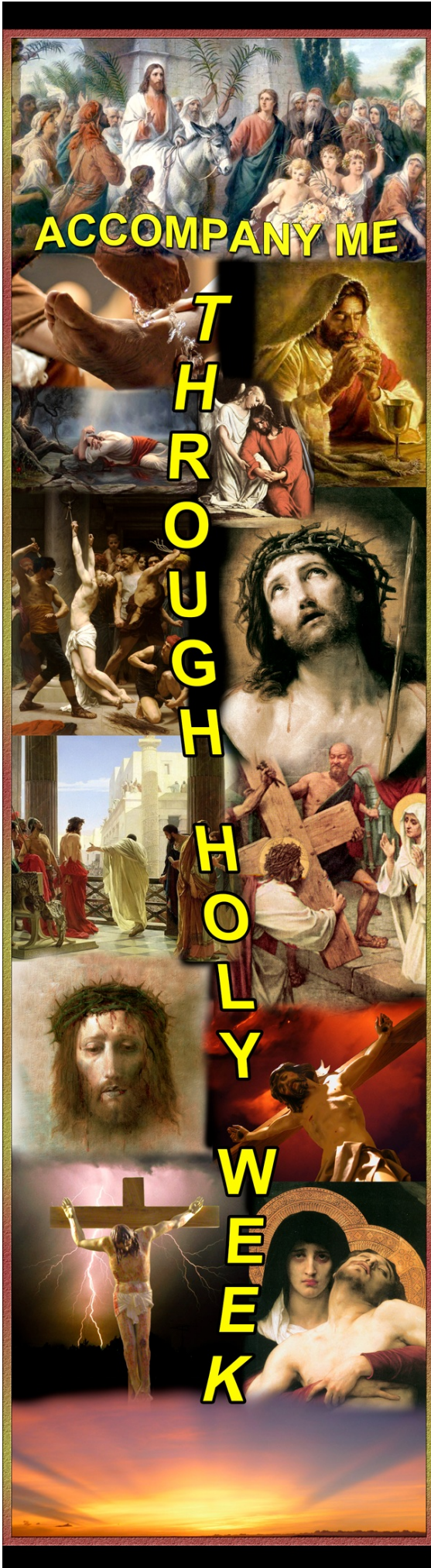

Proposal for Gathering Space, Offices & New Rectory

St. Anthony's current parish facility was built in 1954 with the addition of the Catechetical Center shortly after. No major changes or additions have occurred for the last 50+ years. The church is constructed in a small, high end neighborhood just west of the Buffalo Bill Historical Center. The population of Cody in 1955 was about 4,000, and currently at 10,000. Parish population rise is similar.

The members of the parish frequently desire a gathering space at ground level, with all weather access. It is proposed to utilize the living room, dining room and kitchen areas of the existing rectory as this gathering space with ADA restroom facility and minor kitchen facilities for informal gathering around mass periods. The existing covered breezeway from the northwest door to the main parish would be enclosed by a wall on the east to provide easy, dry access year-round.

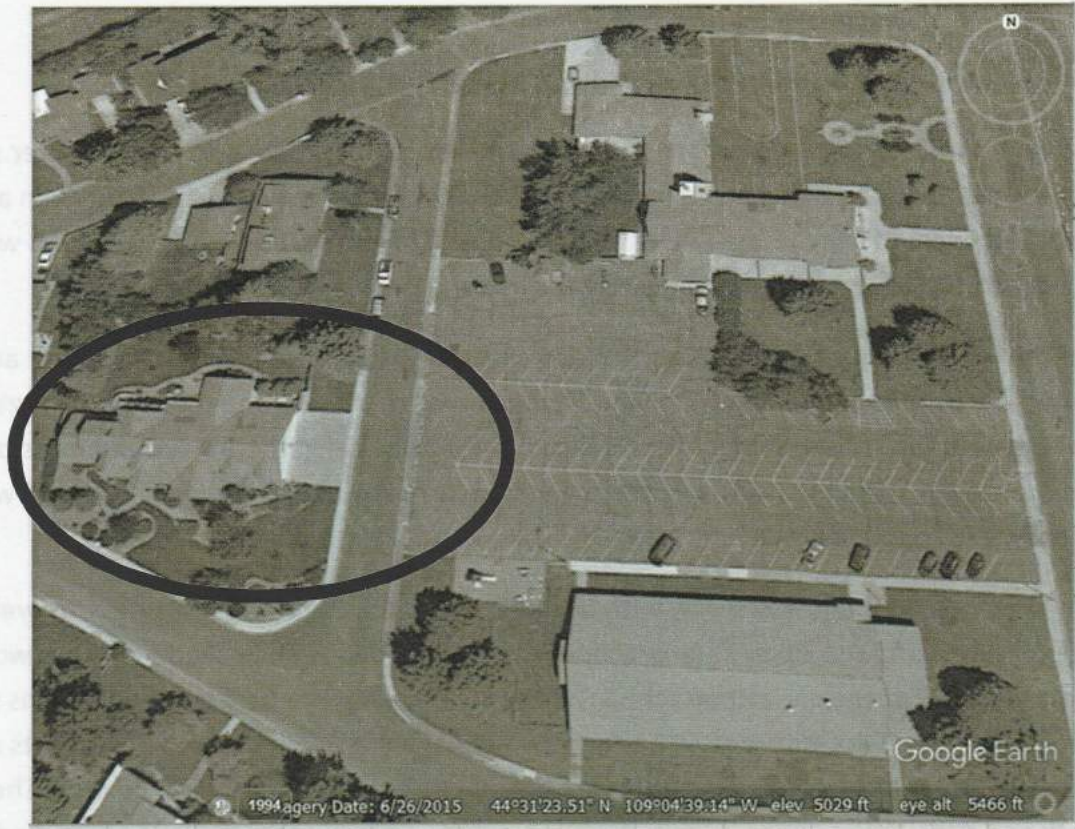
Currently assigned are a pastor and associate, with normally an additional transition priest, as well as summer increase as visiting priests come to cover Yellowstone National Park needs and vacation of the two resident priests. Bedrooms available at the current attached rectory are four (4). The basement bedrooms share a single bathroom facility that is dormitory style having two toilets and a single shower. The priests currently have limited privacy as the personal/sleeping areas are accessible to anyone in the office area. The basement quarters are stark and dark. Office space is limited, with 2 private offices, receptionist's office, and a printer area shared by the bookkeeper and any additional priests. The rectory living and dining rooms are used daily as overflow meeting/counseling areas. Currently there is room to park a single priest's vehicle indoors (pastor) as the garage doubles as storage area for parish needs. The pastor's RV is used as overflow sleeping quarters during the summer.

It is proposed to purchase a new rectory in the neighborhood that has come available over the last few years. The building has 5 current bedrooms and could sleep 9 if needed, has a 4-stall garage, is directly across the street from the parish in, and is available at a discounted price. (1319 Sunset Blvd S)

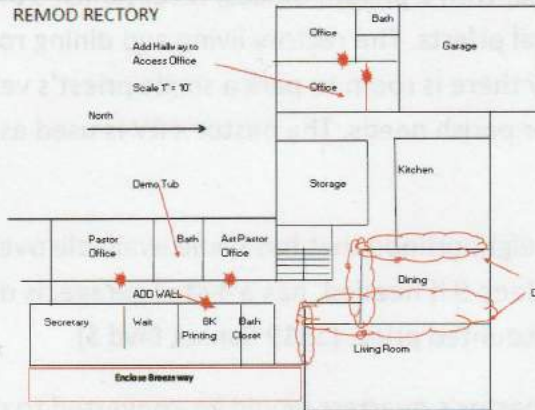
The two main floor rooms currently used as the pastor's quarters would be converted to offices. We plan to replace the carpet in Brady Hall, the downstairs large gathering is, and paint this room as needed.

We are asking for the approval of the Bishop of Cheyenne to proceed with negotiations and purchase of this property for the long-term benefit of the Catholic Parish in Cody Wyoming.

Expenditures is below our current saving/investment account balance, so no loan or fundraising campaign is anticipated.

- Steps of remodel**
- Electrical upgrade to meet code of floor 1
 - Demo walls in living dining, add new load bearing headers
 - Demo tub in bath near pastor's office, and pastor's bedroom
 - Add hallway to convert 2 pastor rooms to office
 - Add wall for printing Bookkeeper office with door
 - Carpet in new gathering area, Living Dining, hall ways
 - Paint as required
 - Cover ceiling tiles with sheetrock
 - Improve lighting in gathering area.
 - Kitchen only used for coffee, snacks - parish meals in main hall
 - Enclose exterior breezeway to allow covered access to new gathering area from church, most
 - Add Lock to door
 - Convert Pastor's bath to ADA compliant
 - All door must be 36" minimum, change out 2 doors
