CALLING WYOMING COLLEGE-AGED YOUTH!!

The Diocese of Cheyenne is searching for charismatic young Catholics 18 and older to help with our Totus Tuus summer program. The missionary team will be composed of two men and two women who will spend eight weeks traveling to parishes across the great state of Wyoming to provide summer programs for children aged K-12th grades.

You must be good with kids and willing to be a little silly. You also must be a practicing Catholic, living your faith, but you do not need to be a theologian. Prior to the camp, you will receive easy-to-follow teaching materials, along with a week of practical training, as well as community building, prayer, and spiritual growth opportunities.

Training will be the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> week in May, summer programs run June 3-July 28. This is a missionary role, so the stipend is humble, but the experience is life-changing. All Meals and lodging are provided during our mission work.
