Close to 70 students from St. Anthony's, St. Barbara's, and Our Lady of the Valley joined together with the Wyoming Diocese Totus Tuus team. Wyatt, Aaron, Mackenzie and Ella inspired our young people with their energy and enthusiasm for the Catholic faith. The team of four college students is traveling throughout Wyoming, bringing the Totus Tuus Youth Camp to 7 parishes this summer.

Totus Tuus is Latin for "Totally Yours," St. John Paul II's motto, taken from St. Louis de Montfort's "True Devotion to Mary." The program has a noted Marian focus, with a different theme every year that ties into Marian devotions, such as the Rosary. This year's theme was centered around the Sorrowful Mysteries.
