

You've Asked For It - and it's coming **June 1st**

A Lively, Engaging, Humorous, Mind-blowing Class and Discussion on our Faith. You will learn different aspects of your faith from different angles, from different horizons and yet interconnected with one other. The discussion will be called "**Being Catholic**" and will cover what we believe, what we do and what we think, and we do think differently! This discussion is open for everyone: life-long Catholics, converts, serious teens, non-Catholics who are curious about the faith and those who are planning to enter the Church.

The discussion will be on Thursday evenings at 6:30 PM in the Joan of Arc room in the Parish Center. The first discussion will be "**Reality 101**," led by Deacon Rick and will begin Thursday, June 1st. We will discuss the "Holy Trinity - it's not just a triangle," and how this understanding is essential to the understanding of our faith and of life itself. We will discuss the "Truth - and ("yes, you can handle it.") We will discuss the "ISMS" and just about anything that comes up. This discussion may last two or three weeks. Some other topics under consideration are: "Born Again Catholic" by Tom Caudle, "Mary, the Mother of God," "Sacramental Theology," "Anamnesis and the Cosmic Mass," the "Protestant Reformation," "Vatican II and the Zeitgeist of the times," "Prophecy and the Anti-Christ" and a favorite, "God did not create the universe in six days! Or did He?!" There are many, many topics with various speakers who will inspire you, teach you and blow your minds (aspirin will always be available).
