

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2019

My beloved brothers and sisters, we have just heard some of the most awesome words in the Sacred Scriptures: “Before you were formed in the womb, I knew you. Before you were born, I appointed you...” These words said to Jeremiah the prophet are said to every human being brought into existence in their conception.
