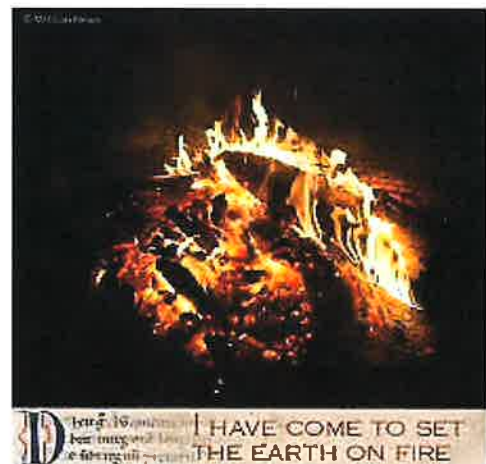



GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Today's readings acknowledge the real challenges of living our faith. Following Christ will sometimes put us at odds with others – an uncomfortable reality that many will face in our broken and divided world. Yet we can find strength knowing that Jesus understands the constant opposition (both inward and outward) that we face. The second reading says, “Consider how he endured such opposition from sinners.” Jesus knows what it’s like to face opposition, but he endured it “for the sake of the joy that lay before him.” That is our calling too. We are made to know the joy that awaits us beyond our crosses. We find the strength to persevere through our trials by “keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus.” Keeping Christ as our focus, we will be able to overcome any obstacle we may face and run toward the goal of heaven.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In today's Gospel, Jesus said, “I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing.” Jesus’ desire is that the whole world be set aflame with his love, and yet, he knows that this will not come easily. The good news is that Jesus is with us in the midst of the struggle. He too knows the deep longing and even anguish (the Gospel today uses that word!) that we experience as we work so that others may come to know God’s love. We can take comfort in the fact that as much as we want to see others come to faith, God desires it even more than we do, and he is also pouring out his grace continually upon us. In the midst of any discouragement we may feel about those who seem opposed to God and to faith, may we remember the burning love that Christ has and his immense desire to draw all people to himself.

PRAY

Pray for those whom you may know who seem closed to the Gospel, or who are away from the Church. Invite the Holy Spirit to touch your heart with a particular love and zeal to pray for them, that those who may seem the most opposed to faith might come, one day, to embrace it.

Living and Giving in Christ: Unity Through Diocesan Ministries An annual appeal, *Living and Giving in Christ* kicks off each year the first or second week of May. The goal amount is set annually, as calculated by the Office of Finance.

~\$2.3 million is estimated for this coming 2025 fiscal year, which ends 6/30/26.

Funds raised for this annual appeal are used to maintain immediate and ongoing ministries, including direct support for:

- Clergy
- Parish leaders
- Faith formation for all ages
- Hispanic and campus ministries

In addition, *Living and Giving in Christ: Unity through Diocesan Ministries* monies make possible healing ministries, like those offered by the Offices of the Tribunal and the Chancellor, while also enabling Chancery Staff in the Offices of Human Resources, Finances, and Communications to assist every parish.

All gifts to the annual appeal, no matter the amount, are received in gratitude, responsibly managed, and returned to each giver, as those funds support the infrastructure behind every parish in the Diocese of Cheyenne.

Both efforts are essential, although they serve different purposes and timeframes. The campaign focuses on long-term growth and development; while *Living and Giving in Christ* addresses immediate and ongoing needs.

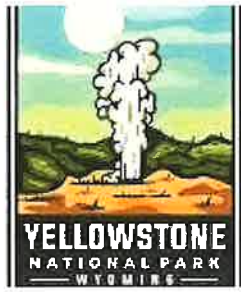
EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

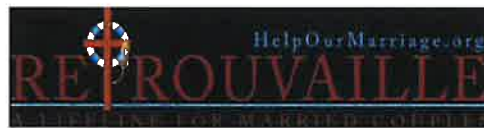


Make a will. Make an impact rooted in faith.
